- **Will this project reduce anti-social behaviour in our area?**
- Will it make this Ward a better place to live?
- Is there a need for this project?
- Can you achieve it?
- Is it good use of public money?

Proposals with the highest score will get the money until the money runs out.

### **Do you want to apply for the money?**

You need to be 16 years old or above, but if under 18 years old you need to be supported by an adult.

You need to be 13 years old or above, turn up on the day and register before noon. You need to stay and vote on all the applications. It will be fun and there will be FREE refreshments. You will be influencing what happens locally and making Smallshaw, Hurst and St. Michael's a better place for us all to live and work.
