# Charity Football Match for Children

Next Tuesday (31st July), employees of New Charter will compete in a 90 minute football match at Curzon Ashton's Football Ground, in aid of local registered charity, "Jacks Little Stars", which has been set up in memory of a brave and courageous little boy Jack Joseph Starowojtow.

Jack was diagnosed with a rare, aggressive form of childhood cancer on 29th June 2004, and devastatingly lost his battle with the disease at 4.55am on Monday 10th April 2006 at the Royal Manchester Children's Hospital aged just 5 years and 8 months. Coincidentally, he would have been 7 years old next Thursday.

New Charter has contacted his mum, who is expecting a baby anytime and she is thrilled that this match is taking place and will be honoured to go along and present a trophy to the winning side. Anyone is invited and all that New Charter ask is for people to donate a minimum fee of £2.

Mrs Starowojtow said, "I am still devastated by Jack's death, but fundraising and this charity appeal will help raise awareness of this disease which is the biggest cause of death in children aged 1-16 years old and can strike any family at any time".
