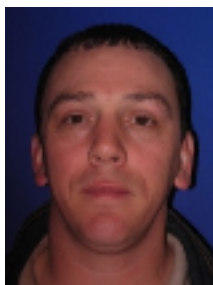

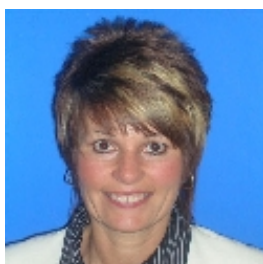
Since becoming involved with New Charter in 2004, he has contributed to a variety of groups including communications and web design.

Independent Board Member

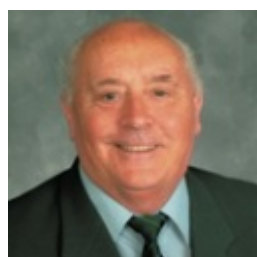
Joan is the Trust Board's nominee on the Board and is also Chair of the Group's Finance Committee.
